- **YOU MUST GO IN ORDER!!** *(Example: #1 Books of the Bible memorized & recited BEFORE Psalms 23 or, Psalms 37 read and report completed BEFORE I Peter is started.)*  
A TOTAL of \$150 in Camp Bucks may be earned by combining memory & reading reports.  
The FINAL deadline to turn in all Camp Buck work is Wednesday, June 8th!
