
In 1978, a group of 40 faithful individuals began gathering in the library of CDO High School with a shared mission: to plant a Nazarene church in Oro Valley and share

Ver the last six years, OVCN leadership has been in a strategic planning mindset. We are prayerfully considering how to meet the current needs of our church family, while keeping an eye on the future and where God is leading us. As our church family has grown, our needs have changed. It's clear to us that we need church facilities that can meet the physical needs of our growing congregation. We need gathering space that will take the lid off capacity and outreach limits. We need space for our Next Gen Ministries so we can provide biblical teaching and environments that prepare our kids for the culture around them. We need facilities that make room for those in our community who don't yet have a church home.

The goal of these new, expanded facilities is to open up seats for people to hear the Gospel. Our facilities will be the tool God uses to minister to families, visitors, and those in need so that they may fully experience the power of God through the local church.

PROJECT OVERVIEW



Final details will be updated and optimized as the Decade to Make a Difference project progresses. Here are the key areas of need:

1. Sanctuary:	New worship venue with seating for 1,500
2. Baby Church/Early Childhood:	Expanded space for birth to kindergarten
3. Multi-purpose Room:	Middle school ministry, worship venue, gym, food and fellowship area, special events
4. Promenade:	Connection space for Next Steps, visitors, cafe, and church family engagement
5. Conference Center:	Classrooms and meeting space for Students, other OVCN ministries, and community outreach
6. Columbarium:	Final resting places for loved ones
7. Back Porch:	Intentional outdoor space to connect buildings, and create community engagement
8. Chapel:	Original sanctuary to be renovated into a traditional chapel
9. Building B & C:	Fellowship hall and office
10. Building A:	Current sanctuary to be renovated for Student Ministry
11. Kidz Zone & Third Space:	For Kids Ministry 1st-5th grades and community gathering space
